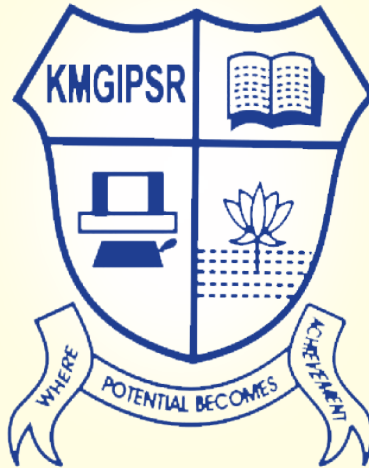

## 1. PROFILE OF THE INSTITUTE

Kanchi Mamunivar Government Institute for Postgraduate Studies and Research (KMGIPSR) in Puducherry is a government-run institution under the administration of the Directorate of Higher and Technical Education, Government of Puducherry. Established in 1989, its objective is to provide affordable higher education at the postgraduate and research level to both urban and rural communities. Affiliated with Pondicherry University, KMGIPSR offers sixteen postgraduate programmes and eight doctoral programmes across Arts, Humanities, Commerce, and Science disciplines. Since 1993, the institute has received recognition under sections 2f and 12B of the UGC Act, 1956.

In the first cycle, NAAC accredited this Institute with a B++ Grade in 2005 and subsequently re-accredited it with an “A” Grade in the second cycle in 2013. During the third and fourth cycles, the Institute was re-accredited with a B++ Grade in 2019 and 2024 respectively and ranked 77<sup>th</sup> by NIRF in 2024 among all Arts and Science Colleges in India. The University Grants Commission (UGC) conferred Autonomous Status on this Institute for a term of six years from 2007-08 to 2012-13, which was further extended for a second term up to 2018-19. The UGC has granted autonomy for the third term starting from 2020-21. Besides, the Institute was awarded the status of “College with Potential for Excellence” for a period of five years from 2009-10 to 2013-14 (Phase-I), which was then extended for another five years up to 2018-19 (Phase-II). The Institute is also recognized as a research centre by Pondicherry University.

Since gaining Autonomous status in 2007, the Institute has implemented significant changes to the curriculum and syllabus, incorporating recent advancements in Science & Technology. This has enabled the PG students to compete with peers from other reputable institutions both nationally and internationally. The Institute adopted the "Choice Based Credit System" (CBCS) in 2012-13, allowing students to choose among different streams of hard-core/soft-core courses, and enabling them to improve the standard and quality of their knowledge and skills. The revised CBCS has been implemented from 2019-20, incorporating Audit courses in addition to Non-Audit Courses for skill development. The autonomy in teaching methods enabled the Institute to align with the needs of industry and the broader employment market, facilitating Industry-Institute Interface. This has resulted in an increased number of industrial visits and internships being integrated in the curriculum.

Since June 2015, a partnership with IIT Bombay has offered free and open-source software training to students. This collaboration with IIT Bombay's FOSS training is intended to integrate it into the Value-Added Courses, providing wider learning opportunities and promoting skill development. The Village Adoption Scheme, part of the Institute's extension activities, has raised awareness among stakeholders about health and environmental issues. The Institute has signed a number of Memoranda of Understanding (MoUs) without financial implications, and thereby enabled many students to improve their skills. The Academy for Competitive Examinations and NET provides coaching and guidance for the National Eligibility Test (UGC-NET & CSIR-NET) and other competitive examinations. As an Associate member of the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII), the Institute facilitates industrial training for students in their fields of specialization. Tuition fees are waived by the Government for students admitted to the Institute.

Due to a positive public perception about the Institute, the student enrollment has increased significantly in recent years. Various student and society-friendly initiatives have been implemented, such as herbal medicinal plants, language laboratory, sanitary napkin incinerator facilities, Wi-Fi connectivity, CCTV surveillance, creating an eco-sensitive garden, mushroom cultivation, organic manure project and freshwater fish culture pond. The Institute has received national-level projects funded by UGC, DST, AYUSH, etc. The faculty members are experienced and have guidship for Ph.D. programmes. Research papers are being published in high-impact factor journals indexed in Web-of-Science and Scopus. Most of the postgraduate students secure placements in government, research institutions, and industries on completion of their programmes, while some pursue higher studies or post-doctoral fellowships.

### 3. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

(1) Candidates will be selected for admission based on their academic record, specifically the aggregate marks in all semesters or years of the qualifying degree programme (**Part III course marks only**).

(2) **Mode of Applying:**

(a) Candidates may download the Application Form, Prospectus, Address Slip, and Bank Challan from the Institute's website (<https://kmcpgs.py.gov.in>).

(b) Print the Application Form, complete it, attach copies of the required documents, and submit it either by speed post, or in person to the following address:

(c) Before filling in the application form, go through the Prospectus thoroughly.

(d) Fill up the Address Slip with the correct **Postal Address** to ensure timely delivery of admission letters and other information.

(3) Candidates are required to submit separate **application form** for each programme.

(4) Once admitted to a particular programme, candidates shall not be allowed to move from one programme to another, except specifically applied for it.

(5) **Enclosures:**

The completed application form in all respects must be accompanied by self-attested photocopies of the following certificates, which should be current and issued by competent authorities.

- a) Transfer Certificate and Conduct Certificate from the Institution last-studied.
- b) Mark Sheets/Grade Sheets of the Qualifying Degree.
- c) Nationality Certificate.
- d) Residence Certificate.
- e) Community Certificate.
- f) Rural Certificate.
- g) Certificates in support of the claim for reservation under Persons with Disability (PwD)/Freedom Fighter (FF)/Ward of Ex-service Men (ESM)/Meritorious Sports Person (MSP), if applicable.
- h) Cumulative Health Record.

**Note: The original certificate along with three recent passport-size photographs must be submitted at the time of admission.**

- (6) Applications submitted after the last date will not be considered for admission.
- (7) Upon receiving applications, applicants will be informed with a registration number. This number must be referred in all further communication regarding admission. Inquiries without quoting the registration number will not be addressed.
- (8) Within a week's period after the last date, the comprehensive list of candidates who have applied for admission will be displayed on the Institute's Notice Board and Website.
- (9) Candidates will be considered for admission strictly based on the selection criteria mentioned in the prospectus, and the final list will be published on the Institute's Notice Board and Website.
- (10) Based on the merit list, admission letters will be sent to all the selected candidates.
- (11) A candidate eligible for admission under reservation is also entitled to admission based on open merit or resident merit, as applicable.
- (12) If a candidate is absent on the scheduled date of admission to the specific programme, his/her name will be removed from the list of candidates for that programme. However, he/she will still be considered for other programmes, if applied for separately.
- (13) Candidates may be required to report to the institute for admission at their own expense. The Office of the Director will notify the candidates of the date and time of the admission. If provisionally selected for admission, candidates should pay the prescribed fees immediately.
- (14) If seats are still vacant after the admission of the first list, a second merit list will be prepared, excluding the candidates who were absent during the first admission process, and admission memos will be issued to those selected in the second merit list.
- (15) Community Certificate issued by competent authority of Government of Puducherry will only be considered for claiming reservation under various categories.
- (16) Sports Certificate must be countersigned by the appropriate authority of Government of Puducherry.
- (17) Candidates who have studied in Lycee Francais and opt for PG Programme should produce an eligibility certificate issued by the Pondicherry University, subject to fulfillment of other eligibility conditions.
- (18) After admitting all eligible candidates of a specified reservation category, if seats still remain vacant, they will be transferred to the Unreserved category for admission.
- (19) After exhausting all rounds of the admission process, if the sanctioned seats in a particular programme remain unfilled by residents of the U.T. of Puducherry, candidates from the non-resident category may be considered for admission, if applied for it.

## 7. NATIONALITY CRITERIA

For the purpose of admission to all the PG programmes, a candidate seeking admission should be an Indian National. However, French Nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the Treaty of Cession shall be treated on par with Indian Nationals.

## 8. RESIDENCE CRITERIA

### (a) RESIDENTS OF THE U.T. OF PUDUCHERRY

An applicant is considered to be a resident of Puducherry if he/she is an **Indian National** and satisfies at least one of the following criteria:

- i) The candidate or whose parent (either Mother or Father or Both) or Guardian (in case of children who have lost both the parents) has been residing continuously in the Union Territory of Puducherry for at least five years preceding the last date for submission of application.

**(OR)**

- ii) Those candidates who have passed SSLC/HSC/UG or any other public examination and for that purpose had undergone academic studies continuously **for 5 successive years immediately preceding the qualifying examination** (including the year of qualifying examination) in a recognized educational institution located in the U.T. of Puducherry and having their residence in the U.T. of Puducherry for 5 years continuously during that period. **Mere stay in places such as residential hostels would not amount to residence.**

**(OR)**

- iii) Children of natives of the U.T. of Puducherry, who have declared any place in the U.T. of Puducherry as their hometown and so certified by their respective Heads of Office, Nativity Certificate in the prescribed format has to be enclosed (G.O. Ms. No. 64 dated 25<sup>th</sup> May 2006).

**(OR)**

- iv) a) Children whose parents are Central/ State Government Servants/ Defence Personnel/ Central Paramilitary Forces/ Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially owned either by the Central Government or by the Puducherry Administration posted and have been serving in the U.T. of Puducherry for at least a minimum continuous period of **three** years immediately prior to the last date for submission of application.

**(AND)**

- b) Children of the above-mentioned employees should have studied HSC / S.S.L.C./UG for two years in any of the schools in the U.T. of Puducherry and should have passed the qualifying examinations (HSC/ S.S.L.C./UG) from the same school (G.O. Ms. No. 04,

Puducherry dated 09.02.2016 of the Chief Secretariat (Hr. & Tech. Edn.), Puducherry.

**(OR)**

- v) Children of Defence Personnel killed or disabled in harness and children of Central Government Servants/ Puducherry U.T. Government Servants/ Defence Personnel/ Employees of Public Sector Undertakings wholly or substantially run either by the Central Government or by the Puducherry Administration who died while in service in the U.T. of Puducherry.

**(OR)**

- vi) French nationals residing in the U.T. of Puducherry and covered by the terms of the “Treaty of Cession” shall be treated on a par with the candidates who produce the prescribed Puducherry U.T. Residence Certificate. Such French nationals will not be required to produce Residence Certificate; instead, they should produce a “**Certificate of Registration**” issued for this purpose by the French Consulate at Puducherry. However, Children of these French nationals shall not be considered for admission under the Non-Resident quota.

**(b) OTHER STATES**

“Other States” refers to seats to students who are Indian Nationals and not Residents of the Union Territory of Puducherry.

**9. RESERVATION OF SEATS**

Reservations for admission to various postgraduate programmes for candidates from the Union Territory of Puducherry are provided according to the norms prescribed by the Government of Puducherry. The vertical and horizontal distribution of seats by category is outlined below. Community certificates issued by the Government of Puducherry only will be considered for claiming reservation under SC/ST/BT/EBC/MBC/BCM/OBC. Candidates eligible under these reservations are also eligible for admission under the Unreserved (UR) Category in addition to their reserved quota.

\* **Horizontal Reservation** (For Puducherry Residents only):

Horizontal Reservation (FF/PwD/ESM/MSP/Rural) will be done if adequate number of seats in horizontal reservation are not filled after fixing vertical reservation i.e., if the requisite number of seats are not filled while doing vertical reservation, then the last candidate in the respective category will be replaced as per merit.

### **Unreserved (UR)**

The seats under Unreserved are open to all candidates irrespective of their caste or category status. Further, all SC / ST / BT / EBC / MBC / BCM / OBC candidates are also eligible for selection under the unreserved category in addition to the reservations due to them.

### **Other Backward Classes (OBC), Most Backward Classes (MBC), Extreme Backward Classes (EBC), Backward Classes Muslims (BCM) and Backward Tribes (BT)**

Candidates claiming admission under these categories should enclose OBC / MBC / EBC / BCM / BT certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue and Disaster Management, Government of Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

### **Scheduled Castes (SC)**

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as a Scheduled Caste under “**the Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Castes Order 1964**” dated 05.03.1964, read with “**the Constitution (Scheduled Caste) orders (Second Amendment) Act 2002**” (Central Act 61 of 2002) and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Government of Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

### **Scheduled Tribe (ST)**

Candidates claiming admission under this category should belong to a caste which is recognized as a Scheduled Tribe under “**the Constitution (Puducherry) Scheduled Tribes Order, 2016**” dated 22.12.2016 and should enclose the required certificate issued by an Officer of the Department of Revenue & Disaster Management, Government of Puducherry, not below the rank of Deputy Tahsildar.

### **Freedom Fighter (FF)**

Candidates claiming admission under this category should be Children / Grand Children of Freedom Fighters and they should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Officer-in-Charge, Freedom Fighters’ Cell, Government of Puducherry, Puducherry.

### **Person with Disabilities (PwD)**

Candidates seeking admission under this category should be residents of the Union Territory of Puducherry suffering from not less than 40 per cent of any disability as certified by a competent Medical Authority, Government of Puducherry. They should also produce a full-size photograph exhibiting deformity.

### **Wards of Ex-servicemen (ESM)**

Those who are registered as Ex-servicemen in the Department of Sainik Welfare (DSW), Government of Puducherry and have got an Ex-serviceman / Widow of Ex-serviceman identity card from DSW should enclose the necessary certificate issued by the Director, DSW, Puducherry.

### **Meritorious Sports Person (MSP)**

- i) The highest achievement of the candidates in only one annual tournament under the listed sports disciplines in a year will be considered for awarding marks.
- ii) The list of Sports Disciplines eligible for seats under sports quota is given in **Annexure II**.

Selection of candidates under this category will be based on the marks obtained by the candidates following the guidelines given by the Government of Puducherry vide G.O. Ms.53 dated 24<sup>th</sup> May 2012 and G.O. Ms. No 6 dated 14<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 of Chief Secretariat (Higher & Technical Education), Government of Puducherry.

- iii) Participation / Achievements in sports / games shown in the above list in the five years immediately preceding the year for which admission is sought only will be considered. National / State Level Championships / Tournaments conducted by Organizations / Federations recognized by Indian

Olympic Association / Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, New Delhi only will be considered for award of marks (Recognition by the Indian Olympic Association / Ministry of Youth and Sports, New Delhi should be relevant to the period of years concerned).

- iv) Open /Invitational Tournaments of any kind will not be considered.
- v) For Tennis, Achievements of Top 3 players by his/her position in the ranking list published by AITA based on the ranking rules and the final rankings of the previous 4 years will be awarded marks for achievements and participation (Necessary credentials from such Associations are to be enclosed).
- vi) For Cricket, the Annual Official Championship / Tournaments conducted within the country under the auspices of BCCI at District / State National Level only will be taken into consideration for that year.
- vii) The participation / achievements of candidates with nativity of Puducherry Union Territory and who represented the Union Territory of Puducherry only are eligible for marks under National Category.
- viii) Candidates are eligible to apply for admission under Sports Quota even if they have studied in KVS/NVS/CBSE Schools within Puducherry.
- ix) All the achievement certificates are to be supported necessarily by the relevant participation Certificates and appropriate forms /certificates.
- x) No further enclosures of certificates will be entertained after the last date for submission of completed applications.
- xi) A candidate can utilize the sports quota only once for these admissions.
- xii) The relevant attested copies of the certificates issued by the appropriate authorities as detailed in the G.O Ms. No. 53 dt. 24.05.2012 are to be submitted along with the application.
- xiii) A Committee will be constituted to scrutinize the applications received under this category and it will rank the candidates based on the marks assigned to the certificate/s enclosed along with the application and the sports merit list will be published in the Institute's website/Notice Board.

**Note:**

The list of eligible sports Disciplines for seat under Sports Quota will be as per G.O. (latest if any) issued by the Government of Puducherry from time to time.

**Students from Rural Schools and Colleges**

Applicants seeking admission under the rural category must have completed five years of continuous study immediately preceding, and including, the year of qualifying examination in a Rural Government School and Government Colleges located within the jurisdiction of the respective Commune Panchayats listed by the Government of Puducherry for this purpose (Refer **Annexure III**). The certificates for rural category must be endorsed by the Head of the Institution of the Government School and College in Puducherry.

**Note:**

Candidates seeking admission under this category should submit the prescribed application with all relevant documents about Residence, Nativity, and Community (original certificates are not required at this

stage). It is sufficient for candidates to declare in the application that all the information provided is correct, acknowledging that false information will result in cancellation of their candidature. Candidates must present their original certificates supporting their **Residence, Nativity, Community, etc.** at the time of admission.

I) Total marks of all semesters/ years are to be compared (including all Part subjects).

II) In case the total marks result in a tie, it will be resolved using Date of Birth. A candidate of higher age will be ranked higher.

## 12. ADMISSION PROCESS

- a) The Candidates will be called for admission as per the order of merit.
- b) The admission will not be done in the absence of a candidate.
- c) Candidates called for admission must submit all the ORIGINAL certificates for verification. Extension of time will not be given to produce them on a later date.
- d) Candidates are advised to take adequate number of photocopies (xerox) of the original certificates before submitting for verification during the admission process.

## 15. OTHER INFORMATION

The postgraduate programmes at this Institute adhere to the Semester system. Each academic year comprises two semesters, each lasting 15-16 weeks. The Institute operates from Monday to Friday. The faculty members are highly qualified in their respective disciplines and are authorized to supervise Ph.D. scholars. The academic programmes encompass a wide range of activities including formal lectures, tutorials, integrated MOOCs, group discussions, library, research projects, assignments, seminars, workshops, internships, viva-voce, and other modern teaching methods.

### a) Assessment

To qualify for a pass in a subject, a student must fulfil the following criteria:

1. Obtain a minimum of 40% in the End-Semester Exam (ESE) (24 out of 60 Marks).
2. There are no minimum marks required in Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) (CIA is out of 40 Marks).
3. Achieve a minimum of 50% in aggregate when ESE and CIA marks are added.

All students, except those studying Tamil and French, must write examinations in English only, which is the medium of language. Answers written in any language other than the medium of instruction will not be evaluated.

### b) Minimum Attendance

Students should attend all classes regularly and punctually. Students must secure a minimum of 75% of the attendance in each semester to be eligible for the End-Semester Examinations. Failure to meet this attendance requirement may result in disqualification from appearing for the exams.

### c) Supplementary Exam

Students who have failed in not more than two courses across the Third and Fourth Semesters are eligible to appear in the Supplementary Exam. The exam will be conducted soon after the declaration of the End-Semester Examination results.

#### **d) Repeat the Programme**

Students who fail to secure a minimum 75% overall attendance based on the classes conducted each semester will be required to redo the programme. This can be done when the programme is offered in the ensuing batch, subject to additional payment in accordance with the established norms.

#### **e) Discipline**

The Institute aims to uphold a high standard of discipline among its students. Students are expected to comply with any general or special rules set by the Institute from time to time and must provide written declaration in the prescribed form. This form should be signed by both students and parents/guardians in the presence of the Director of the Institute.

Students are advised not to affiliate themselves with any political party or organization within or outside the institute campus.

- The use of alcohol and intoxicating drugs within Institute premises is prohibited.
- Students should refrain from participating in agitations and demonstrations.
- Students should carry their Identity Card issued by the Institute at all times.
- Any act of disobedience or misconduct by a student will be reported to their respective parent/guardian and will be viewed seriously, potentially leading to suspension, dismissal, or other actions depending on the severity of the misconduct.
- The Director of the Institute reserves the right to issue a Transfer Certificate to any student at any point of time during their programme due to indiscipline, non-payment of fees/dues on time, or continuous absence from class for more than 10 days, requiring the student to leave the Institute.

#### **f) Anti-ragging**

As per the notification issued by the Ministry of Education, Government of India, New Delhi (letter No. 9-18/2008 [U-5] dated 29th April 2008), ragging is prohibited and carries severe penalties, including imprisonment for up to two years. Any student found participating in any form of ragging will be immediately expelled from the Institute. At the time of admission, candidates and their parents are required to sign an undertaking to acknowledge this condition.

#### **g) Medical Examination of Students**

Candidates who are provisionally selected for admission to the Institute are required to undergo a medical examination by the Students Health Officer and provide the original Cumulative Health Record at the time of admission.

#### **h) Students' Co-operative Stores**

All students are required to enroll as members of the Students' Co-operative Stores.

#### **i) Scheme of "Grant of Full Fees"**

According to G.O. Ms.No.8/Wel (SCW)/2020-21/3808 dated 04.01.2021 by the Government of Puducherry, the Adi Dravidar Welfare and Scheduled Tribes Welfare Department implements the "Grant of Full Fees" scheme. This scheme provides full fees for eligible SC/ST (Origin) students, without considering income limits, for Higher/Professional courses ranging from 1st Standard to Research Studies. The scheme is applicable to two children per parent.

This scheme provides eligible SC/ST (Origin) students with coverage for tuition fees, including examination fees, lab fees, book fees, uniform fees, and other non-refundable fees.

**Therefore, the eligible SC/ST (Origin) students are exempted from paying the tuition fee at the time of admission.**

**j) The PM-Vidyalaxmi Scheme**

The PM-Vidyalaxmi Scheme, a Government of India initiative offering collateral-free and guarantor-free education loans is available for all meritorious students who get admission in this Institute and who are desirous of availing education loans to pursue higher education.
